

Requirements

A participant must:

- Be registered with the Boy Scouts of America
- Be at least a 1st Class Scout
- Have attended at least 1 long-term camp.
- Be at least 13 years of age
- NYLT Baden-Powell requires a BSA Class 1 & 2 Medical Form #34414

Each participant will need a list of equipment and a medical form prior to their course. The medical form may be reused if issued within the last 3 years (doctor's signature and date).

What is the Cost?

National Youth Leadership Training NYLT- Baden Powell \$160

The total cost for the full 6-day course includes meals, training materials, tents, cooking stoves, handouts, insurance, and activity materials.

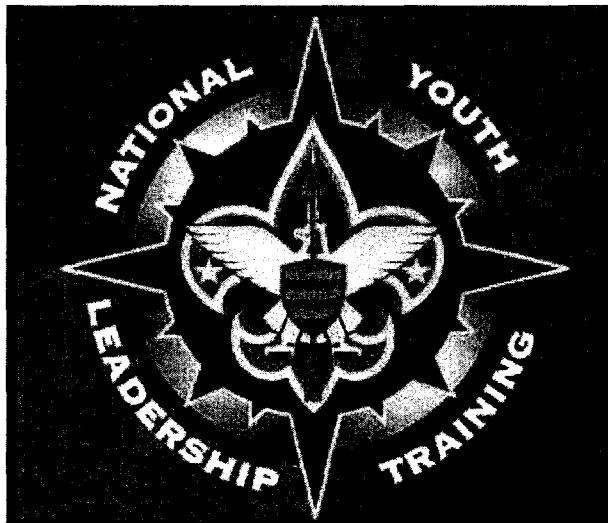
Each course is staffed and the budget set to handle up to forty-eight participants. The Ore-Ida Council reserves the right to cancel a course if there are not enough participants to make the course financially viable. Each course is limited to forty-eight (48) participants. **SIGN UP EARLY.**

DEPOSIT: A \$50 will hold your place.

EARLY SIGN UP: A \$15 discount is given if all fees are paid in full by the early pay deadline of June 6, 2008.

REFUND POLICY: 75% of the fees paid may be refunded if the Scout Service Center is notified before June 30, 2008. No refund will be given after that date; however, all fees paid may be transferred to another Scout.

What is National Youth Leadership Training?

National Youth Leadership Training course (NYLT) is an opportunity for all Junior Leaders in the Scout Troop, Varsity Team or Venture Crew to learn how to be effective leaders in their unit. Young men learn Leadership Skills while participating as temporary members of a training troop or team.

NYLT is complimentary to the Wood Badge adult leadership course. Every Scout Unit should have trained adults and youth leaders for efficient unit operations and optimum youth development.



National Youth Leadership Training

Baden-Powell: The NYLT Baden-Powell course is open to 13 to 17-year-old Scouts. The NYLT-BP course takes place in the Training Area at Camp Morrison on the East side of Payette Lake, North of McCall, Idaho. The setting is similar to Scout camp, but instead of earning merit badges, Leadership Skills are taught using the patrol method while playing Scouting games, using Scout skills and participating in fun activities. Two NYLT-BP courses are scheduled each summer to accommodate vacation schedules.



NYLT Baden- Powell

The 2 NYLT Baden-Powell courses take place over a 6-day period Monday morning to Saturday afternoon. Each session is conducted by a well-trained staff who practice the leadership skills they teach. The participants experience these leadership skills in action and learn the patrol method taught by Baden-Powell himself.

No local unit adult leadership is required for the course. The entire program is directed by the Council approved adult and youth volunteer staff. The staff is trained to present the NYLT course.

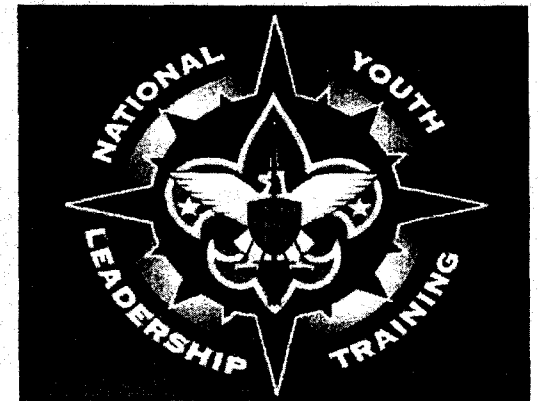
