As a staff we are excited about our 2009 Wood Badge course. We'd like all of you to join us, but we can only take 48!

Wood Badge for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century is for the whole family of scouting from Cubs through Venturing, and District and Council leaders. You will learn contemporary leadership skills that will change your scout units, your workplaces, and your families. This is a FUN course as we mix classroom learning with games and activities that reinforce the teaching sessions.

Some things you will learn and practice in the patrol format include:

- Creating a vision and mission
- Communication skills
- Team development stages
- Leadership styles
- Problem solving

The formal portion of the course will be completed in two three-day weekends, September 10-12 and 24-26, 2009. The course fee includes training materials, food, and beautiful scenery. To attend Wood Badge, you must:

- Be a registered BSA leader
- Have completed basic training
- Complete a BSA class 3 physical
- Be able to function safely outdoors

The informal portion is the completion of your Wood Badge Ticket which includes goals written while you are on course. You will have 18 months to complete this portion.

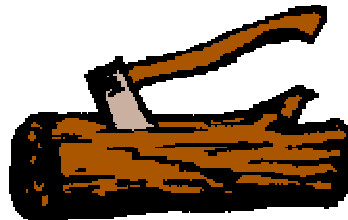
